The Essex is due to open in May. Scotch Plains Tavern will also be opening soon. Wrights will be changing to have a more family friendly setting. Mr. Needleman introduced Russ Smith who is the representative from Zoning. Zoning is still organizing and reviewing the regulations. The revised regulations will be available for review and will then go to public hearing. The STEAP Committee is making decisions regarding how to spend the STEAP funds. WPCA will be doing a study to decide what the needs of our town is. Retailers in Essex are concerned about the empty spaces.

Mr. Seidman suggested that we focus on an anchor activity in the village and decide what sort of marketing to do. The creation of an ad-hoc committee to work with EDC and the business owners.
