# Required & Valid for **Household Garbage Only**

Garbage is generated by the day-to-day activities of a household. Use only 33 gallon bags or smaller for household garbage and put into the single trash compactor.

Examples of Household Garbage Food Waste, Food Wrappers, Styrofoam Packaging, Kitchen & Cooking Waste, Bathroom Trash

Items prohibited from Household Garbage Any items of hazardous nature such as flammables, pesticides, chemicals, gas cylinders; items must go to the Estuary Region Household Hazardous Waste Facility
