TOWN OF ESSEX NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Essex, Connecticut, will hold a Public Hearing in the Essex Town Hall Auditorium, 29 West Avenue in said Essex, Wednesday, November 19, 2014 at 7:00 pm for the following purpose:

1. To receive public comment on the proposed \$8,085,000 Town of Essex 2014 Capital Program Initiative to be financed by grants and the issuance of general obligation bonds of the Town.


The Board of Selectmen expects to call a Town Meeting on December 3, 2014, to discuss the proposal, and to hold a vote by Adjourned Town Meeting Referendum on December 15, 2014. The projects and questions to be voted upon at the referendum are expected to be stated as follows:

1. Shall the \$2,845,000 appropriation and general obligation bond issuance authorization for the replacement of Walnut and Ivory Street bridges pursuant to the resolution adopted by the Boards of Selectmen and Finance, be approved? YES/NO
2. Shall the \$2,815,000 appropriation and general obligation bond issuance authorization for improvements to Essex Elementary School pursuant to the resolution adopted by the Boards of Selectmen and Finance, be approved? YES/NO
3. Shall the \$1,300,000 appropriation and general obligation bond issuance authorization for improvements to Town Hall pursuant to the resolution adopted by the Boards of Selectmen and Finance, be approved? YES/NO
4. Shall the \$525,000 appropriation and general obligation bond issuance authorization for improvements to the Town Garage pursuant to the resolution adopted by the Boards of Selectmen and Finance, be approved? YES/NO
5. Shall the \$600,000 appropriation and general obligation bond issuance authorization for the purchase of a fire fighting vehicle pursuant to the resolution adopted by the Boards of Selectmen and Finance, be approved? YES/NO
