## Effective October 1, 2014

### Household Garbage & Trash

#### Annual Stickers or Punch Cards Required

Trash generated by the day-to-day activities of a household is to be put into the single trash compactor. Use only 33 gallon bags or smaller. Items include food waste, food wrappers & styrofoam packaging.

Items prohibited from household trash include any items of hazardous nature such as flammables, explosives, pesticides, chemicals, gas cylinders and oil-based paint. These items must be taken to the Estuary Region Household Hazardous Waste Facility.

### Single Stream Recycling

All of the following items may be put into the single recycling compactor. **No Fee.**

#### **Books:**

3-ring notebooks  
Hardcover  
Paperback  
Telephone

#### **Paper:**

Junk Mail  
Magazines  
Newspaper  
Office (white/colored)

#### **Boxes:**

Boxboard  
(cereal, pizza, etc.)  
Corrugated Cardboard  
Egg Cartons  
Aseptic/Wax Cartons  
(milk, juice, etc.)

#### **Plastic:**

#1-2 Bottles (<3gal)  
#3-7 Bottles  
Milk Jugs  
Detergent Bottles  
Water Bottles

#### **Cans:**

Aerosol Cans (non-toxic)  
Aluminum & Tin  
Glass (Jars & Bottles)

### NO FEES for the following items

(see the attendant on duty for the appropriate disposal location.)

#### **Antifreeze**

Clean Antifreeze ONLY (not mixed with motor oil)

#### **Electronics/TV's/Computers**

#### **Fluorescent Light Bulbs & Tubes**

#### **Paint**

April 1 – Oct 1 Only  
Latex or oil-based paint & stain ONLY

#### **Waste Oil**

Transmission Fluid	#2 Fuel Oil
Power Steering Fluid	Motor Oil
Diesel Fuel Oil	Kerosene

#### **Leaf Composting Area**

Leaves ONLY (no plastic bags, wood, logs, shrubs, or brush)

### Betty Pierson Recycling Building

This area provides a drop off location for reusable items that residents want to offer to their neighbors. Wooden furniture, household items, bicycles, etc., in good condition, may be left here.

Residents may take items for their personal use.

Gasoline or gasoline mixed with oil, wood preservatives or deck sealers, solvents, thinners or turpentine, propane cylinders, PBC-ballast light fixtures, explosives, pesticides, gas cylinders, chemicals.
