

In Connecticut you must belong to a political party in order to vote in that party's primary. If you are registered as unaffiliated, you may switch to a party up to the day before that party's primary. If you are registered in a party, but want to vote in another party's primary, you must switch to that party at least 90 days before that party's scheduled primary.

In 2014 the scheduled date for statewide primaries is August 12, 2014. So, to switch party's in order to vote in a different party primary, you must switch prior to May 14, 2014.
