

TOWN OF ESSEX REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The Town of Essex is seeking proposals for survey and design of the intersection of Main Street and Summit Street in Ivoryton, including pavement renovation/treatment, curbing, sidewalk installation, landscape/lighting improvements, and drainage renovation as well as the addition of hardscape design such as an at-grade “Village Seal” in the intersection.

The Town of Essex has received a Main Street Investment Fund (MSIF) grant to accomplish “Ivoryton Village Intersection: A Shared Street for the Arts” enhancements, including:

- a) Removal of existing traffic island;
- b) Milling and resurfacing the central intersection of Main Street and Summit Street, including potential pavement texture treatment;
- c) Expansion of curbing at Ivoryton Playhouse corner to narrow crossing distance across Main Street;
- d) Installation of new sidewalk to connect municipal parking area at park with existing sidewalk network;
- e) Improvements drainage at central intersection as needed;
- f) Installation of four new crosswalks;
- g) Installation of at-grade “Village Seal” in center of intersection (design for Seal will be provided by Town); and
- h) Installation of lighting and landscape enhancements for continuity and village enhancement.

The Town requires cost estimates for the proposed design, a set of plans and specifications for the bidding and construction of these enhancements; it is anticipated that the Town will undertake general contractor/construction inspection services in-house.

Firms interested in being considered for this assignment should submit a statement of interest, general information about the firm and similar projects, and a cost proposal for the engineering design above the above-described project, including costs for preparation of plans and specifications for bidding and construction.
