PART TIME PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT LABORER

The Town of Essex is presently accepting applications for a **temporary** part-time (24-32 hours per week) seasonal position in the Public Works Department from June through November. Salary for this position is commensurate with experience.

Candidates must be able to perform physical labor that includes the use of chainsaws, lawn-mowers, weed-whackers, shovels, rakes and other tools related to the responsibilities of the Public Works Department.

Candidate Requirements Include:

- Valid Connecticut Motor Vehicle Operator's License.
- The ability to apply common sense and to carry out instructions that are furnished in written, oral or diagrammatic form.
- Ability to acquire skills to operate construction equipment (such as a truck, payload, curbing machine, roller, tractor, jack hammers, chainsaws, chippers, and hand tools and to acquire skills to make mechanical repairs).
- Ability to lift and/or carry objects of 25 to 50 pounds.
- Ability to work in extreme weather conditions, including heat or cold, with temperatures sufficiently high or low enough to cause marked bodily discomfort.
