NEW BUSINESS

Centerbrook and the Bokum Center area may be two trouble spots that the Authority may want to propose a site specific community system. An RFQ may be considered. This will continue to be discussed in the future.

REPORT – LISA FASULO, HEALTH DIRECTOR

A cesspool is being removed from a property in Ivoryton and replaced with a modern conventional septic system. Pump out reminder cards have been sent. A summary report of all septic system repairs will be available in January from Ms. Fasulo. A friendly reminder to the local Realtors® and an article in Essex Events will state the disclosure guidelines for septic systems.

REVIEW OPERATING STATEMENT AND INCOME STATEMENT

The budget was discussed. This balance of the sinking fund will be clarified. Water quality testing in Essex Village was discussed. It was decided by the Board to continue with water quality testing.
