Approval of Agenda:

Office Christopher B. McCarthy received his Post Officer Standards and Training (POST) certification on March 10, 2016.

Maria Lucarelli earned her Masters Degree in Public Administration at the University of New Haven.

A Request for Qualifications for development of a wastewater facilities plan will be posted shortly.

A thank you letter was received by the Town for an outstanding job on the code update classes being held in the auditorium by the Building Official David DeLeeuw.

The clean energy fair and LED bulb swap on April 9th was a huge success. 230 families received a bag with 5 LED bulbs in exchange for 5 incandescent or compact fluorescent bulbs. The switch will save Essex residents approximately 82% of the energy used by incandescent bulbs.

Capital Committee

Bruce Glowac reported that the renovations at the Essex Town Hall will be starting at the end of the month. The auditorium air conditioning is expected to be installed mid-May. The Park and Recreation sheds have been moved over to the Grove Street Park parking lot during construction.

The Route 9 Bridge is being painted.

Eversource is changing the location of the utility poles on Blake Street and there was discussion on the new poles that are being inserted into the sidewalks is shortening the sidewalks significantly.

Neighborhood Assistance Act - The Community Music School

The Neighborhood Assistance Act is designed to provide funding for municipal and tax exempt organizations by providing a corporation business tax credit for businesses that make cash contributions to these entities. The application process requires a public hearing, which was conducted earlier this evening and approval by the governing body of the municipality.

SELECTMEN GENERAL DISCUSSION:

<u>Budget</u>

Finance Director Kelly Sterner reported that she has prepared a preliminary forecast and currently expects the Town budget to finish the fiscal year \$160,000 to the good. Kelly said we have lost PILOT grants and a portion of the ECS grant from the State but should still finish on the positive side. At this point, the municipal grant in aid from the state totaling almost \$75,000 is about 2 months late. If this is rescinded, the forecasted surplus will be significantly reduced.

Sound System

There was discussion on a sound system quote that was received for the auditorium. The system will have microphones and a ceiling mounted projector. There was discussion on looking at other mounted projector options.

Motion was made by Norman Needleman to adjourn the meeting at 8:24 p.m. Bruce Glowac seconded the motion. All in favor.
