1. Call to Order and Seating of members:

Chairman Tom Danyliw asked for a report from Attorney David Royston on the status of appeals and other legal filings related to the approval of the Foxboro Point subdivision. Attorney Royston stated that the Commission is in receipt of copies of legal appeals from Frank Sciame (applicant) and Cunningham et al. (neighbors), as well as a mandamus action from Frank Sciame and a Freedom of Information (FOI) request from Frank Sciame. The return date for the appeals is November 13, 2012, and Attorney Royston will confirm that the appeals are filed with the Court. He further requested authorization from the Commission to act with respect to the appeals.

Attorney Royston stated that in his opinion, the Commission had a very strong legal position on the appeals and the issues raised therein, specifically concerning the allegation of the expiration of timeframes and extensions and the other substantive allegations.

Motion by Neil Nichols to authorize Attorney Royston to: file an appearance in each of the recent legal actions on behalf of the Commission; file appropriate pleadings when they are required; and make inquiries with the appellant parties as to whether they have interest in entering into mediation per Section 8-8a of the

Connecticut General Statutes. Motion seconded by Carla Feroni. Motion unanimously approved.
