Traffic Authority

Earl Street / Earl Street Extension

Mr. Needleman stated that Public Works improved the signage on this street and this item would be removed from the agenda and revisited in 6 months.

Ivory Street - No Parking Signs

Mr. Needleman reported that he had received a request from Officer Gingras to have no parking signs installed on the west side of Ivory Street. During events, such as Illuminations, temporary no parking signs are placed along Ivory Street on one side because cars are parking on both sides and on the sidewalks. SELECTMEN GENERAL DISCUSSION:

Sidewalk Snow Removal

There was discussion regarding snow removal on sidewalks. Three scenarios were discussed.

- 1. To continue the way it has always been done with homeowner's responsible for shoveling their sidewalks but to do add a public relations campaign to everyone to encourage do their part by clearing sidewalks of snow.
- 2. To create an ordinance requiring people to do it.
- 3. To have the Town responsible for clearing the approximately 9 miles of sidewalks. This could be done with additional staffing and the purchase of sidewalk snow removal equipment or contracting out the sidewalk snow removal for the Town.

There was a reminder that there is no parking on the streets during any time that there is plowing.

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Capital Committee

Mr. Needleman met with a team from CME Engineering regarding bridges in the Town. There was discussion on the bridges, some needing repairs and some that would need full replacement. There was also discussion on the culverts. Some are in bad shape.

There was discussion on the Town Hall kitchen by the auditorium and whether an architect would be needed to do plans for both the kitchen and the second floor.

There was discussion on safety officers at schools.

Motion was made by Stacia Libby to adjourn the meeting at 8:08 p.m. Joel Marzi seconded the motion, it was unanimously approved. Motion carried.
