Brief Description of Project:

I would like to replace an existing structure (shed) that is located on the back north-west corner of my property with a new structure (2 car garage). The intent is to have the garage built in the same location as the currently existing shed but extend the dimensions of the new building further into my property.

The size of the current shed is 10 x 14 feet. (140 SQ FT)

The minimum suggested size for a 2 car garage is 20 x 20 feet. (400 SQ FT)

As I still need the storage that the current shed provides me, my intent is to size the garage to accommodate the 2 cars and still be able to use it for storage.

Ideally, I would like to size the garage to be 20×28 feet (560 SQ FT) – which is only 20 SQ FT larger than if I were to keep my shed and build the minimum sized 2 car garage of 20×20 feet.

The garage I plan to have built is a simple one-story garage similar to what is pictured below, but instead of placing the entry door to the storage area in the front of the structure next to the 2 garage doors (as shown in the picture) I will move it to the southern facing side of the building (i.e. the side that faces the back of my house).
