

The Town of Essex is constructing a sidewalk along the southern side of River Road from the end of the existing sidewalk extending from North Main Street to the driveway entrance at Heritage Cove. The sidewalk is approximately 3,400 ft long and is constructed completely in the River Road right of way, as shown on the attached plans.

On the site plan, the sidewalk is marked with station numbers starting at 0 + 00 to 34 + 00. At station 2 + 90, the grade of the sidewalk requires placement of a retaining wall adjacent to the flagged wetlands to the existing bridge abutment. A pedestrian bridge will be installed over the Falls River, which bridge will require construction of foundations. The foundations will be built on the landward side of the existing wingwalls. On the east side of the pedestrian bridge and the east side of the existing River Road bridge at approximate station 4 + 25, the sidewalk will again require a retaining wall, which varies in height from 2 ft to 4 ft. Installation of the retaining wall will require removal of trees on the existing embankment.

Adjacent to the existing wingwall, a portion of the retaining wall will be in wetlands covering approximately 20 sf. At station $6 + 80 \pm$, the retaining wall will end as the sidewalk moves north to go around a 48 inch diameter sycamore tree.

Beyond the sycamore tree the sidewalk will no longer require a retaining wall. From station 7 + 0 to station 11 + 25, the entire River Road will be reconstructed to accommodate an alignment that allows protection of the forementioned sycamore tree. The regulated area associated with the Falls River wetlands ends at approximate station 8 + 50.

At approximate station 14 + 35, the proposed sidewalk is again within an upland review area, which continues until station 24 + 00. At station $16 + 30 \pm$, the sidewalk will be immediately adjacent to a headwall at the outlet of an existing 18" reinforced concrete pipe (RCP). At this location, we proposed to install a catch basin, which will incorporate the existing 18" RCP. Work will be done immediately adjacent to the wetlands identified by wetland flag # 23 and wetland flag # 24.

At station 19 + 0, the design of the sidewalk changes from a monolithic curb to a simple 5 ft wide concrete sidewalk. At the end of the portion of the sidewalk with the monolithic curb, it is necessary to put in a catch basin, which catch basin will be installed with an 18" RCP outletting at the toe of the slope adjacent to an existing stonewall. On the opposite side of the stonewall, there are wetlands in close proximity, identified by wetland flag # 32 and wetland flag # 33.

At station 20 + 15, the sidewalk will again be constructed immediately adjacent to a headwall, which headwall is at the outlet of an existing 18" RCP. No catch basin is required at this location and there may be minor temporary wetland disturbance adjacent to wetland flag # 38.

At station 22 + 0, the sidewalk must again crossover an existing drainage pipe and be constructed immediately adjacent to an existing headwall. The drainage pipe at this headwall is a 30 inch RCP. Construction of the sidewalk may involve a small amount of temporary disturbance at wetland flag # 47 and wetland flag # 48.

The sidewalk remains in the upland review area to station 24 + 0. The amount of grading associated with construction will be minimized as we try to match existing grade as much as possible with the finished sidewalk grade. From station 24 + 0, to the end of the sidewalk at station 34 + 0, there are no wetlands within 100 ft of the proposed construction.

Typically, when we construct sidewalk and roadway on behalf of the Town, there are often minor site modifications required to accommodate conditions found as we excavate for the proposed sidewalk.

In summary, there would be approximately 0.4 acres of activity within the upland review areas and approximately 20 sf of construction activity within the wetlands.
