NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special Town Meeting will be held in and for the Town of Essex, Connecticut, <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>January 5</u>, <u>2022 at 4:45 pm</u> in the Essex Town Hall, West Avenue in said Essex.

## TO ACT AND CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING:

- To consent and approve of the appointment by the Board of Selectmen of one (1) regular member to the Planning and Zoning Commission.
- 2. To consent and approve an appropriation in the amount of \$39,820 to be allocated from the American Rescue Plan Act Funds for Tri Town Youth Services, a local non-profit organization. Said funds to be used to fund a per diem clinician to expand and support youth mental health services during COVID. Funding is contingent on the full participation of the Towns of Deep River and Chester.
- To consent and approve an appropriation in an amount not to exceed \$775,000 to be allocated from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funds for the purchase of a Heavy Rescue vehicle by Essex Fire Engine Co. No. 1. Vehicle design specifications support the safety protocol of the Town's first responders during COVID. If ARPA funds are subsequently deemed ineligible, an appropriation from the Fire Department sinking fund in the same amount will be utilized.
- 4. To consent and approve an appropriation in an amount not to exceed \$85,000 to be allocated from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funds for the purchase of a vehicle for the Essex Fire Marshal. The Fire Marshal provides critical emergency response which has expanded significantly during COVID. If ARPA funds are subsequently deemed ineligible, a special appropriation to the fiscal year 2021-2022 in the same amount will be used to provide funding.
