



## TOWN OF ESSEX'S Guide for Voting in the 2020 Election

### **VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT**

You can request an absentee ballot application by calling the Town Clerk's office at 860-767-4340 x129 or by printing the **application** and dropping it in the Official Ballot Dropbox in the parking lot of the Essex Town Hall. Voters ***are strongly encouraged*** to use the Official Ballot Dropbox for all applications and ballots. If you cannot get to the Official Ballot Dropbox, your application and ballot can be mailed. Please be sure to allow plenty of time to mail your application and ballot due to potential delays with the US Postal Service.



### **IN-PERSON VOTING**

The Polls are open at the Essex Town Hall on Tuesday November 3, 2020 from 6:00 am to 8:00 pm. ***You must be in line by 8:00 pm to be eligible to vote.*** You should expect that there will be significant turnout for in person voting this year. Social distancing requirements will limit the number of people we will have in the Town Hall to vote safely. **Please anticipate that it will take longer to vote this year.** Please be sure to wear a mask and be patient with all poll workers as we try to get all votes counted safely and securely.

**ELECTION DAY REGISTRATION** will be on the second floor of the Essex Town Hall from 6:00 am to 8:00 pm. If you are in line outside the Town Hall and are there to register, please see an election official and let them know so you can be directed to the second floor to register and vote.
