# 3. Approval of 4/23/15 Meeting Minutes

The April 23, 2015 meeting minutes were reviewed.

Motion: Joe Zaraschi moved to approve the April 23, 2015 meeting minutes as written. Walter Wiegert seconded the motion. Those in favor: Earl Fowler, John Senning, Walter Wiegert, and Joe Zaraschi; 4-0-0 motion unanimously approved.

### 5. Financial Report

Treasurer Walter Wiegert reviewed the May 28, 2015 Treasurer's report.

# • Town Access Ways

Bushnell Access needs a Porta Potty, which the Town pays for, and the Main Street Dock needs better signage and the stenciling redone.

#### 9. New Business

### • Bushnell Access Small Vessel Storage Capacity

Bushnell Access storage is at capacity and more permits cannot be issued at this time. Checks will be returned to those people who we received applications from and were not issued permits with a letter explaining the situation. A wait list will be started for those and future applications received. The Harbor Management Commission will monitor the situation and possibly increase rackage if it is determined that the site can handle it.

Motion: Walter Wiegert moved that we proceed at outlined above. Joe Zaraschi seconded the motion. Those in favor: Earl Fowler, Walter Wiegert and Joe Zaraschi; John Senning abstained; 34-0-0 motion unanimously approved.

Doug Dominie brought up a letter from an Essex Island boater concerning Police Boat usage and rough water over Memorial Day weekend. Discussion ensued on Police Boat usage and continual issues with its operation.

# 10. Old Business

# Connecticut River Museum

# a. Kayak Program

Tom Klin reviewed the Connecticut River Museum ("Museum") kayak rental plans. Launching will be from the Main Street ramp. Major concerns were raised over safety issues with kayaks introduced into busy, strong current water.

#### b. Dock Usage Review

The Museum is asking for the Commission's support and approval for the COP process to change the permitted use of the Museum's floating docks to allow Museum members limited tie up during Museum open hours only. The details regarding this were reviewed and discussed.

Motion: Walter Wiegert moved that we support and approve the Museum's COP process for seeking the change in floating dock usage as discussed. Joe Zaraschi seconded the motion. Those in favor: Earl Fowler, John Senning, Walter Wiegert and Joe Zaraschi; 4-0-0 motion unanimously approved.

# • Yes/No Piling Update

The Yes/No piling at the entrance to Middle Cove has been "fixed" and now supports a "C" letter in line with the anchorage markers, using black reflective tape.

# • Harbor Management Plan Update

The Harbor Management Plan update project was moved to the next meeting due to the time.

Doug Dominie gave an update on the Amtrak Bridge situation. Issues related to this are possible as there are no spare parts currently available to back up the main gear box which was recently repaired. Amtrak has asked to allow the bridge to stay closed when no boat traffic is in sight to reduce strain on equipment. This is a dangerous situation that could have serious consequences.
