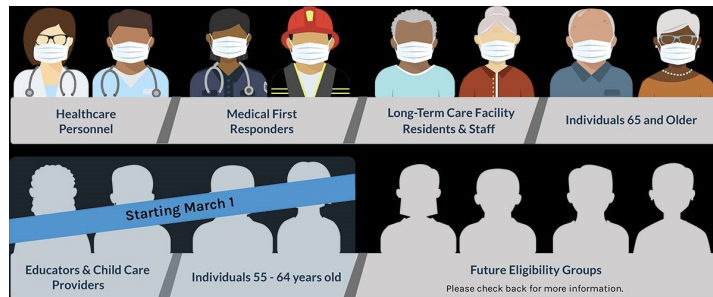

Pharmacy by hosting weekly COVID-19 vaccination clinics. Vaccinations are **by appointment only**. Since the first vaccination clinic was held on January 30, approximately 1,000 vaccinations have been administered to eligible residents who are 55 years and older. 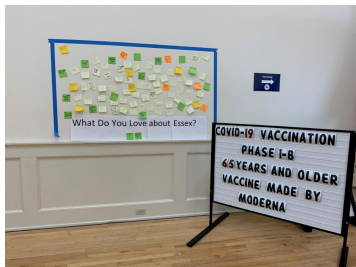
The Governor is expanding vaccine eligibility to those who are 45+, beginning on March 19th. The Essex Health Department and Nutmeg Pharmacy will continue to work through the existing roster to meet our goal of vaccinating those who are most at risk of severe illness from COVID-19. Eligible educators and childcare professionals will continue to receive their vaccine at separate designated clinics. Getting vaccinated is one more step to ending this pandemic. Please continue to wear your mask and maintain social distancing.

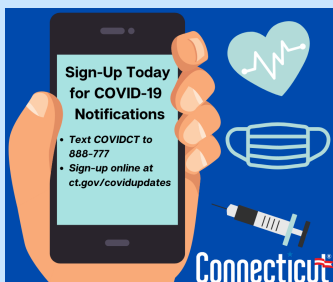
