46 Dennison Rd. London Plane Tree to be planted

6 Donald Rd. London Plane Tree to be planted

163 River Rd. London Plane Tree to be planted

44 Walnut St. Red Oak to be planted.

"Town Strip" along West Ave. American Hornbeam to be planted

The plantings will be completed by the end of December 2014 and must be inspected and approved by Chris Donnelley of the Forestry Division of the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection before the town will be reimbursed for expenses.

6. August Pampel will meet with the donor of the pocket park on North Main St. and with Helane Johnson, the sculptor of the statue to be placed in the park, to agree to the placement of a tree to enhance the landscaping.
